Q How have you adapted to the new normal?

>> With the onset of the pandemic, we quickly adapted to new ways of conducting classes virtually in order to ensure continued education. Right from imparting learning to homework to classwork submissions on the online platforms and giving students a variety of tasks right from online quizzes to recording themselves has been an important part of learning to live in this new world. We have even introduced AI in the middle years' programme as per the CBSE guidelines.

We have also set up various committees to address issues relating to peer pressure and anger management with the inputs from the school counsellor and outside professionals. Having said that, supporting remote learning and hybrid learning will continue to remain our focus for the foreseeable future.

Q Times have changed since the inception of the institute. How have you managed to lead the change with confidence?

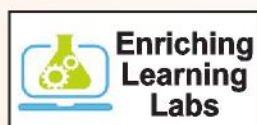
